

# Articulation Agreement Information

## Transfer of Credit & Student Benefits

- Recognize eligibility for CBC students and employees to apply for transfer scholarship programs
- Students jointly admitted to CBC and TWU will receive:
  - Student ID at CBC and TWU
  - Student computer/internet account at CBC and TWU
  - Student access to computer labs at CBC and TWU
  - Student access to libraries at CBC and TWU
- All grades, including F's, will be considered for calculation of GPA to determine admission to TWU. If a transferrable course has been taken more than once at another institution, TWU will accept the best grade awarded to the student for that course.

## Program Admission Requirements

- Student must be concurrently enrolled in and complete the AAS in Dental Hygiene to maintain enrollment in the Dual-Enrollment program
- Earn grades of C or better in all courses
- Statistics, U.S. Government, Texas Government, English II, Ethics, 2 History courses, should be completed prior to taking TWU courses
- Students will receive 37 hours of block credit for successful completion of the Coastal Bend College Dental Hygiene courses.

## Program Specific Requirements

- Total hours for degree 120 hours
- Up to 90 hours transferred from the AAS institution
- 30 hours **must** be completed at TWU. If a student enters into Dual Enrollment and is already core complete, electives will need to be completed at TWU to achieve the 30 hours at TWU. This will vary per student. See TWU Catalog and TWU advisor to assist with current options
- Degree conferred in August of last year if all requirements are met.
