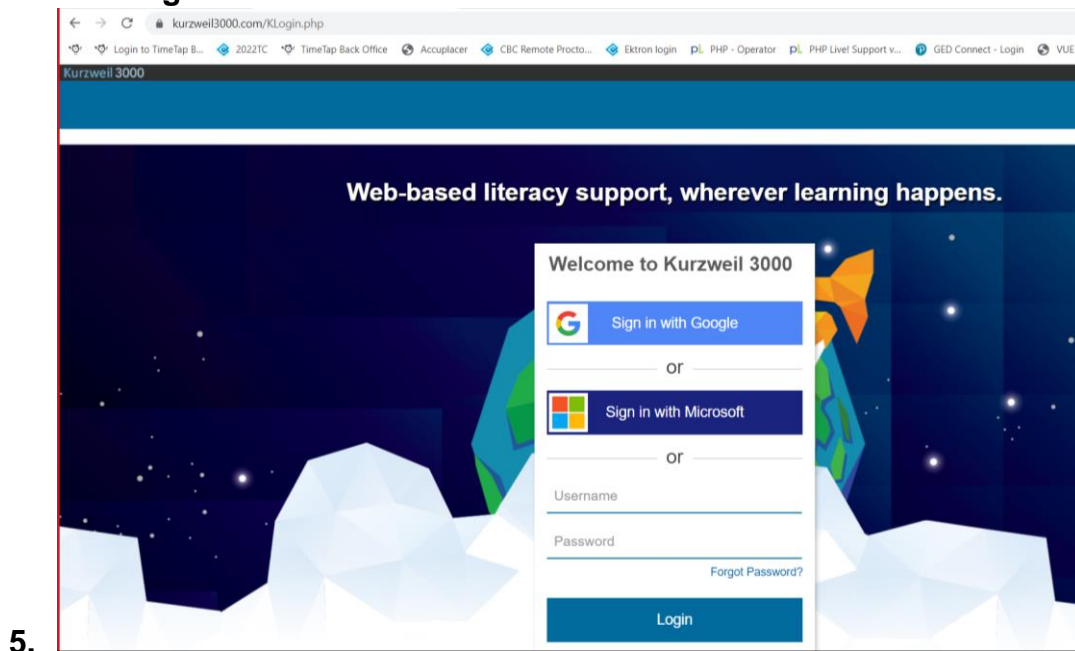

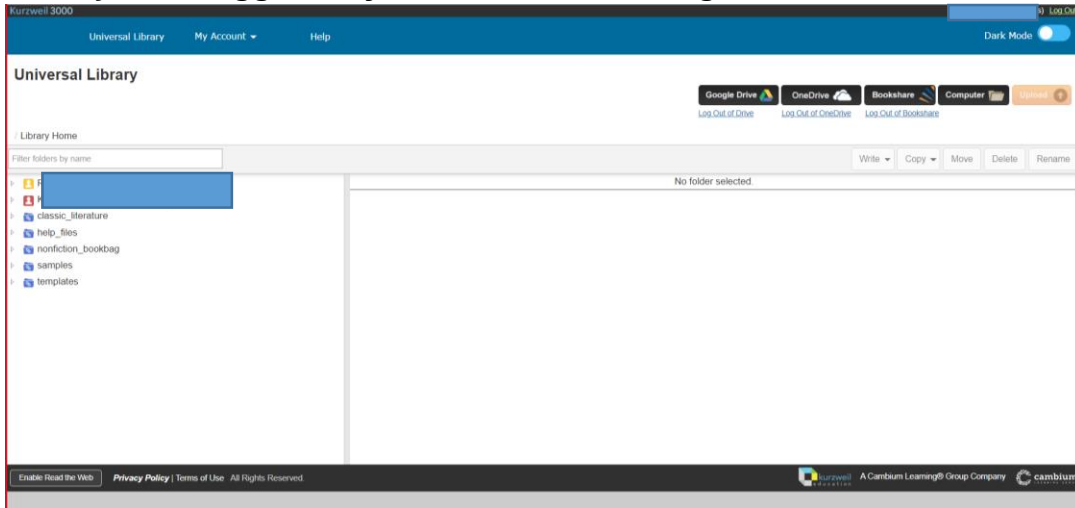

After you've submitted your [CBC Accommodation Request Form](#) through the <http://www.coastalbend.edu/disabilityservices/> site the following will happen.

1. You'll receive an e-mail from Kurzweil 3000 to your CBC e-mail account. If you don't see it in your Inbox, please check your spam/junk folder.
2. Kurzweil 3000 will have sent you your user name. You will then need to create a password.
3. Then you can go to: <https://www.kurzweil3000.com/KLogin.php>
4. See what screen will look like below. Enter your username and password then login.



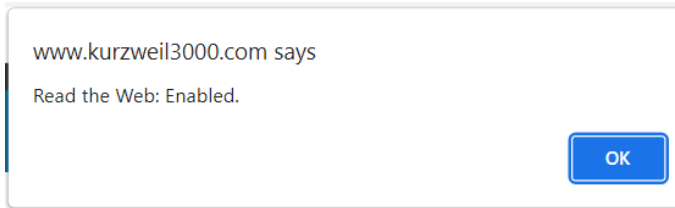
6. Once you've logged in, you'll see the following:

9. You'll then see the following pop-up. Click OK.



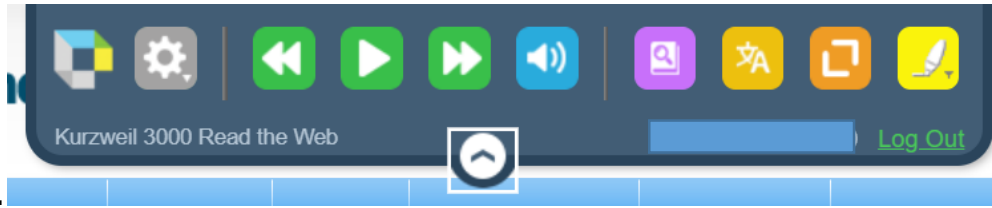

11. Now when you click on the website that you want read to you, you'll see the following:

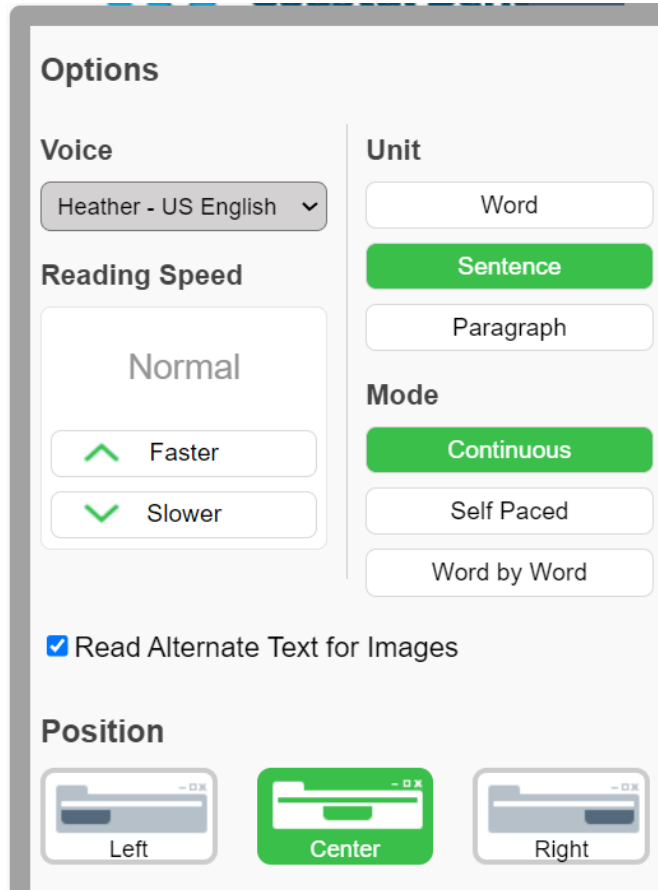

16.  = go back 1 reading unit (Alt+Shift+,)

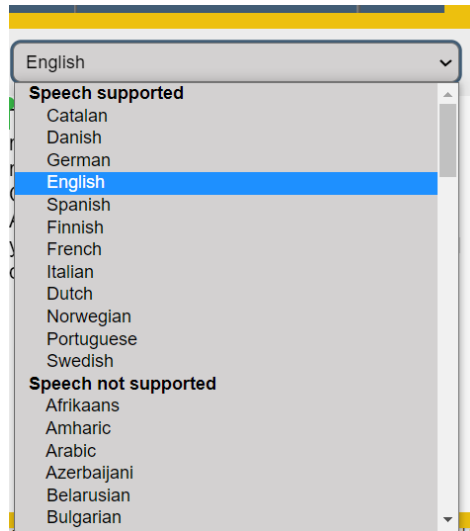
17.  = read (Alt+Shift+P)
